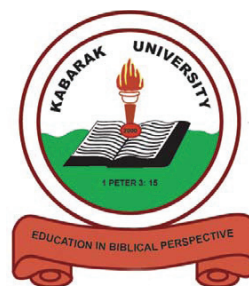

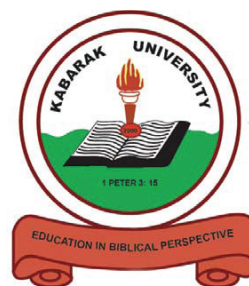

PAPER SUBMISSION:

- Abstract (in soft copy not exceeding 300 words, and typed with 1.5 line spacing) should be submitted not later than **25th July 2011** for articles and poster presentations.
- Abstracts should have key words (not exceeding six)
- Abstract should include the names of the authors, their affiliations and addresses (postal and e-mail, including telephone numbers).
- Two copies of the complete paper, (one hard copy and one soft copy) not exceeding 20 pages should be submitted in A4 size, MS-Word format, Times New Roman with heading in Font Size 14 and the remaining text of the font Size 12 with 1.5 line spacing through the e-mail to [Conference Secretariat](mailto:ConferenceSecretariat@kabarak.ac.ke) on or before **30th August 2011**.
- All the references used in the paper should follow the current American Psychological Association (APA) format.
- Papers previously published elsewhere or currently under review for publication should not be submitted.
