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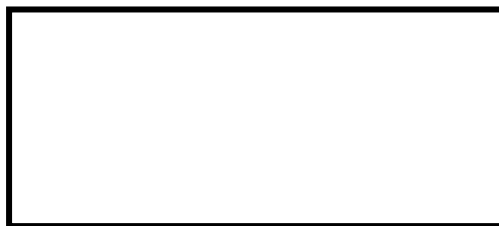

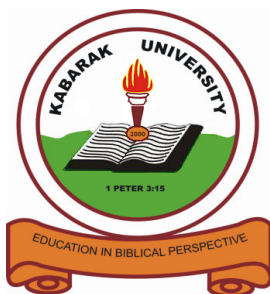

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING STUDENT DISCIPLINE AT KABARAK UNIVERSITY

Introduction

All students enrolled at Kabarak University are expected to follow all regulations and policies meant to govern the behavior and conduct of students as members of the University community. These rules and regulations are formulated based on sound ethics and Christian principles and are founded on the premise that people must treat others with dignity and respect in order for scholarship to thrive. Any violations of these regulations may lead to disciplinary action being taken against the student.

Indicated below are a summary of some of the rules and regulations. You are expected to read through them and sign the declaration if you accept to abide by them. You will later be issued with a student handbook which contains all the rules governing the conduct of the student in all the areas of the University.

1. Academic Responsibility

Attendance to all lectures, assignments, class tests and examinations, is required of all students. It is a serious offence to interfere or block normal scheduled classes.

2. Dress Code

Kabarak University is a Christian Institution where the mode of dressing for students is important. Students are expected to dress decently at all times. Students are not allowed to put on tight trousers/dresses, mini-skirts and skirts with long slits. Clothes with bad slogans printed on them are also not allowed. During worship services and all university formal functions, students are required to dress formally.

3. Church Services

All students are required to attend the Sunday and other mid-week worship services at their respective Campuses.

4. Visitation

The Halls of Residence are the private homes of the residents and should not be entered by guests. Visits to student rooms of residence by members of the opposite sex is **prohibited** in the University.

5. Alcohol, Drug Taking & Trafficking

Use of alcohol, cigarettes, illicit drugs and trafficking of the same is prohibited in all areas of the University. Any student involved directly or indirectly in alcohol or use or trafficking of drugs will be expelled from the University and handed over to the law enforcement agency for legal action, where appropriate.

6. Responsibility for University Property

A student shall take reasonable care of all equipment and property of the class rooms, laboratories, library and at all other places in the University and shall keep them in good condition. Any replacement or repair due to loss or damage resulting from careless use or negligence by the student or persons connected with him/her shall be made at the expense of the student.

7. Harassment

Any form of harassment by a student on or outside the University is prohibited. Such harassment include: Sexual harassment, racial harassment and any harassment targeting those with disabilities.

8. Violence

Students are prohibited from use of or threat of physical violence against other students, employees or members of the University or any other persons lawfully within or outside the University premises. Students shall not keep any offensive weapons within the University as defined in the laws of Kenya.

9. Other offences that could cause dismissal/suspension from the University are:

- a) Undermining the principles and objectives of the university
- b) Possessing obscene literature
- c) Gambling in any form
- d) Stealing and any form of deception
- e) Displaying improper association with members of the opposite sex
- f) Showing disrespect to persons in authority
- g) Arson
- h) Illegal trade or hawking
- i) Bribing any university employee or student
- j) Vehicle hijack or misuse
- k) Sexual immorality
- l) Rape or attempted rape
- m) Authorship, publication and/or distribution of anonymous letters or any other literature of a malicious or libelous nature including placards
- n) Organizing or participating in political activities on campus
- o) Any other obnoxious acts or repugnant conduct as may be prejudicial to good order or other proper functioning of the university
- p) Improper use of internet.

Beyond regulations, however, as a University with a Christian foundation, it is expected that students will strive for Biblical standards of personal character, conduct and discipline in dealing with all people within and outside the University. They should aim at all times in all places, as the University Moral Code states; “To set apart in ones heart Jesus as Lord” (1 Peter 3:15)
