Master of Music Theory, Composition and Performance	Bachelor of Music Second Class (upper); OR Second Class Lower with two years of relevant research, professional or teaching experience; OR Bachelor of Education (Arts) Second Class (upper) with Music as a teaching subject and a minimum of Grade C in composition courses; OR Bachelor of Arts (Music minor) Second Class (upper) and a minimum of grade C in composition Courses, with evidence of a minimum of two years relevant experience and a portfolio of compositions.	65,000
Master of Music Education	Bachelor of Music Second Class (upper); OR Second Class Lower with two years of relevant research, professional or teaching experience; OR Bachelor of Education (Arts) Second Class (upper) with Music as a teaching subject.	65,000

- All certificates, diplomas, or degrees required for admission must be those recognized by Kabarak University Senate and the Commission for University Education (CUE).
- Applicants with KCSE C+ (plus) and diplomas from recognized universities and examiners such as KNEC or KASNEB are eligible for credit transfers in relevant subjects up to the second year of study.
